

Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT) uses medication such as Campral® (acamprosate), Vivitrol®/Revia™ (naltrexone) or Antabuse® (disulfiram), in combination with counseling and behavioral therapies, to treat alcohol use disorder and to help sustain recovery. The medications directly target and normalize the brain chemicals disrupted by alcohol.

MAT has been proven to help individuals modify their behavior and encourage positive lifestyle changes for long-term success.
